# CLINICAL CASES IN THE TREATMENT OF EATING DISORDERS

# 5th International Conference on Eating Disorders NOVEMBER 22-23 2024 MAST. Via Speranza, 42 - Bologna

Fondazione Gruber is organizing the 5th edition of the International Conference on Eating Disorders (EDs), aimed at professionals involved in the psychonutritional rehabilitation of severe patients with eating disorders and psychiatric co-morbidities.

This event aims to contribute to the creation of a space for sharing and in-depth reflection on therapeutic practices and the evolution of treatment pathways for patients with eating disorders (ED).

Through the presentation and discussion of a large number of cases - both national and international, and of historical and clinical relevance - the two days of study will highlight the clinical-therapeutic complexities and the importance of a specialised and personalised approach to the rehabilitation of ED patients, especially in the light of the significant increase in diagnoses and the lowering of age of onset of the disease.

The primacy of the clinical case will be explored through a scientific discussion among authoritative national and international professionals involved in the multidisciplinary context of the Care Network for ED patients.

Who we are

#### FONDAZIONE GRUBER NPO

La <u>Fondazione Gruber</u> is a private non-profit organization operating in the field of nutrition and treatment of eating disorders (EDs) in their various manifestations. Its founding partner is the Fondazione Isabella Seràgnoli that heads a group of foundations working in the fields of healthcare and cultural events. Fondazione Gruber manages healthcare facilities offering both outpatient and residential services and providing specialist care in terms of diagnosis, treatment and psycho-nutritional rehabilitation. The Foundation provides day and residential services through the Residenza Gruber, while outpatient activities are managed by the Centro Gruber. The Foundation collaborates with the National Health Service through a public care network connected to the Mental Health Centers in the Emilia-Romagna region and the rest of Italy.

#### **RESIDENZA GRUBER**

The <u>Gruber Residence</u> is accredited with the Italian National Health Service. It delivers psycho-nutritional rehabilitation to patients needing specialized care for eating disorders.

The therapeutic approach focuses on identifying the most effective treatment for the individual patients. As a result, it is not bound by rigid, ready-made care regimens. It is instead developed as a customized program of treatments and activities. The efficacy of the therapeutic model is ensured by the collaboration of a multidisciplinary team made up of psychiatrists, psychologists, nutritionists, dieticians, nurses, educators and nursing assistants. The facility can accommodate up to twenty people in a residential setting and an additional eight in a daytime program. Patients are welcomed in a homely and serene atmosphere, where even the aesthetics of the available spaces serve a therapeutic function.

#### **CENTRO GRUBER**

The <u>Gruber Center</u>, also accredited with the Italian National Health Service, is a clinic operating in the field of clinical nutrition and nutritional rehabilitation, providing a program of treatment and specialized medicalnutritional advice with a high-quality personalized clinical care model. Care is provided by a multidisciplinary, multi-professional team specializing in nutritional and psychological treatment. This ensures that every patient follows a personalized therapeutic program in line with their specific needs and characteristics.

#### ACCADEMIA DELLE SCIENZE DELLA NUTRIZIONE - ASNU

Through the <u>Academy of Nutritional Sciences (ASNU)</u>, Fondazione Gruber promotes the study, dissemination, research and training of professionals involved in the care of patients suffering from eating disorders or with conditions broadly associated with nutrition. ASNU's activities aim to contribute to the constant improvement of the quality of care, fostering the acquisition of clinical and care skills by members of multidisciplinary teams engaged in the psycho-nutritional rehabilitation of patients.
